




BIO

Gregg T. Daniel is best known for his recurring role as David Carter in HBO's Insecure. He also portrays Reverend Daniels in another HBO hit, True Blood. His recent projects include That Girl LayLay and the upcoming films To Say Goodbye is to Die a Little and Impossible.

With over 100 credits in film and television, Gregg's diverse roles range from comedy (I Am Not Okay With This) to drama (Insecure), procedurals (9-1-1, Grey's Anatomy), science fiction (Star Trek: Voyager), and children's shows (Austin & Ally, Kickin' It). His film credits include Spider-Man 3, 7th & Union, and Truth or Dare. His latest acting role is in Joker: Folie à Deux.

In addition to his on-screen work, Gregg is an accomplished theater director and a founding member and Artistic Director of the Lower Depth Theatre Ensemble in Los Angeles. He was nominated for a 2013 NAACP Image Award for his direction of Kwame Kwei-Armah's Elmina's Kitchen, winning the NAACP Award for Best Ensemble that same year. The actors don't dally or fiddle for motivation. They speak the line and move on w the story - quickly.


